Asbestos - Policy For Dealing With Potential Employee Contact With Asbestos Containing Materials

Objective:

To clarify the role of SFSU employees in dealing with potential asbestos containing materials.

Statement:

Only employees who are properly trained, and authorized by EHS may sample or otherwise disturb materials that are expected to contain asbestos.

Procedures:

- 1. Employees who come upon materials that they suspect may contain asbestos shall not disturb the material in any way.
- 2. Employees shall immediately inform their supervisors and ensure that EHS has been contacted.
- 3. EHS will arrange for sampling and temporary signage as needed.
- 4. If the material does contain asbestos, that information will be forwarded to Capital Planning.
- 5. Capital Planning will record the location of the material, and if necessary, will arrange to address/remediate the situation following the procedures described in the Asbestos Hazardous Work Permit available from the EH&S department.
