Objective:

To clarify the role of SFSU employees in dealing with potential lead-based paint coated materials.

Statement:

Only employees who are properly trained, and authorized by EHS may sample or otherwise disturb materials that are suspected to contain lead-based paint.

Procedures:

- 1. Employees who come upon materials that they suspect may contain lead-based paint shall not disturb the material in any way.
- 2. Employees shall immediately inform their supervisors and ensure that EHS has been contacted.
- 3. EHS will arrange for sampling as needed.
- 4. If the paint does contain lead, that information will be forwarded to Capital Planning.
- 5. Capital Planning will determine how the situation shall be handled following the procedures described in the Lead-Based Paint Hazardous Work Permit available from the EH&S department.
