Objective:

Define the inspection process and responsibility for ensuring the proper posting of required radiation signage.

Statement:

The Health and Safety Code requires the posting of regulatory signs and documents in areas where ionizing radiation is present.

Procedures:

Each year the Radiation Safety Officer will inspect all areas that use ionizing radiation to ensure that the proper signage remains in place and is up to date. Corrections will be made immediately as part of the inspection.
